

Goose Island Rules and Regulations

- No vehicles may be parked on community streets or cul-de-sacs. All vehicles must be parked on rental property, so please plan accordingly.
- No hunting or discharging of firearms or use of fireworks is permitted within the community.
- No open fires within the community. If you are utilizing a fire pit, fire must be contained within pit, maintained to a reasonable size, and never left unsupervised. Fire must be fully extinguished before leaving the fire.
- Recreational vehicles, including boats, must be parked on the property in a location and manner which is unobtrusive and inconspicuous to any passersby. If this rule is not adhered to, you will be asked to remove the vehicle. No recreational use of all-terrain vehicles, dirt bikes, motorcycles or any similar type vehicles shall be permitted within the community.
- No noxious or offensive activity will be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything be done which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood. Quiet times for the neighborhood are 10 pm-8 am, and are enforced. All land in Goose Island is privately owned.
- Each lot will be kept and maintained completely free of trash and garbage. If you have a pet with you, you are responsible to clean up after your pet.
- No lot will be used for any purpose other than residential use.
- Household pets must be kept under control by the pet owner at all times and must be kept on a leash when outside of the residence. Excessive barking is prohibited and is the responsibility of the pet owner.
- If POA property is damaged by you or a guest, you will be financially responsible for reimbursing for damages/repairs.
